


Committee for Backward Classes (OBC/MOBC) Audit Report (2020-21)

The Committee for Backward Classes (OBC/MOBC) of Rangapara College was set up to guide the OBC/MOBC students to pursue their career by utilizing the benefits of diverse schemes offered by Government of Assam rules (EWS-10%, OBC/MOBC- 15%, SC-7%, ST(P)- 10%, ST(H)-5%, PwD-4%, Sports-1%, NCC/NSS-1%, Culture-1%). The cell strictly complies with the rules and regulations of Government of India as communicated by the MHRD and the AICTE with regard to the upliftment of the students and employees belonging to OBC/MOBC communities. The cell organizes awareness programmes, remedial classes, personality development programs and interactive sessions to develop the skills and solve the problems faced by OBC/MOBC students.

In the year 2020-21, a total of 1406 students enrolled in the session. This year, M.A. (Hindi) was introduced along with the existing courses. As 15% of the seats are reserved for OBC/MOBC, a total of 121 seats and 3 seats were reserved for OBC/MOBC students in Graduation and Post-Graduation Programmes respectively. As per the enrolment data, 811 students for Graduation and 6 students for Post-Graduation belonging to OBC/MOBC category took admission in the college. The OBC/MOBC category occupied the seats of the General Category in order of merit. As compared to the previous session, the enrolment of OBC/MOBC students was considerably high. The overall enrolment was found to be satisfactory. Below is a statistical analysis of the session:
