


SC and ST Audit Report (2021-2022)

The Scheduled Caste (SC) and Scheduled Tribes (ST) Cell in the Rangapara College, promotes interests of SC/ST students and guides them to achieve their dreams by utilising the benefits of the schemes offered by the Govt. of Assam rule i.e. EWS-10%, OBC/MOBC15%, SC-7%, ST (P) - 10%, ST(H)-5%, PwD-4% Soprts-1%, NCC/NSS-1%, Culture-1%. The cell adheres to the guidelines of the Government of India as communicated by the MoE and the AICTE with regard to upliftment of the students and employees belonging to the SC/ST categories. The Cell conducts remedial coaching classes, life skills, personality development programs, awareness about ongoing government scholarship schemes, and interactive sessions to develop the personal, social and academic issues faced by the students belonging to SC/ST category. The cell also conducts Training Programmes for Students and Staff both Teaching and Non-Teaching. In the session 2021-2022 a total of 892 students were enrolled under the UG programme (B.A, B.Com and B.Sc.) with 6.05% SC, 53.02% (OBC), 14.79% (UR) and 14.79% ST students. It was found that no. of students belonging to OBC students was highest while least no. of students were belong to the category UR in respect of reservation. In order to fulfil the no. of seats college authorities has decided to adopt following measures.
